

**REVIEW OF ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT OF HARYANA PWD (B&R)
DEPARTMENT FOR THE YEAR 2013-14**

The Public Works Department (Building and Roads) is the principal department of the State Government for the construction and maintenance of roads, bridges and government buildings in the state of Haryana. It has statewide set up offices to accomplish the task of construction and maintenance of roads, bridges and government buildings. It enjoys a strong reputation for engineering capabilities and quality manpower. It has also set up the Haryana State Roads and Bridges Development Corporation Ltd. (HSRDC) Haryana Rural Roads and Infrastructure Development Agency (HARRIDA); Haryana State Buildings & Roads Academy of Research and Training, to achieve its objectives

Building and Road infrastructure have been one of the thrust areas of the State Government right from the beginning. On 1, November, 1966, when the State of Haryana was carved out from the joint Punjab, it launched a massive drive to connect each and every village with a population of 250 and achieved this target by 31 March, 1973. The length of road network increased to 13,322 kms by 31 March, 1973. Now the road length is as under:

FUNCTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

During the year 2013-14, the Public Works Department (Buildings and Roads) carried out its normal activities for the construction and maintenance of Buildings, Roads and Bridges.

1. DEVELOPMENT OF STATE ROADS IN HARYANA DURING 2013-14

Since the formation of Haryana on 01, November, 1966, there has been all-round development in the State especially in the field of construction of roads to link the directory and non-directory villages. Out of 6764 directory villages, as per 2001 census, only 1386 villages were connected as on 01, November, 1966 with the existence of 5100 km. road length. The village connectivity has been brought to 6759 Km and the metalled length has gone upto 27198 km. It has increased 5.30 times as on 31, March, 2014.

2. ANNUAL PLAN TARGETS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

Annual Plan 2013-14 was originally approved for Rs. 2050.00 crore which was finally revised to Rs 2050.00 crore.

During the year 2013-14, a length of 194 km new roads were constructed under Head -5054 and a length of 702 Kms. was improved under same head by the way of widening, strengthening and raising etc.

Rs. 572.00 crore was provided for repair and maintenance of roads. Premix carpet / Surface dressing was carried out on 2026 km. of roads during 2013-14 besides carrying out patch work and other special repair of roads.

Although Total area of Haryana State is 44212 sq km. and the density of roads including the length of National Highways comes out to 0.68 km. per sq. km.

The roads are the basic infrastructure for all the developmental activities and proper maintenance of roads need to be stressed, permanent assets are created by spending huge capital cost. After this, maintenance of these assets is essentially needed which comprises of the following components:-

- (a) Normal maintenance, like keeping the road pavement and shoulders in proper shape and conditions, attending to drainage and repair of culverts and bridges, utility shifting, road signages maintenance of road side structures etc.
- (b) Periodical renewal like bituminous surfacing.
- (c) Special repairs, flood damages etc.
- (d) Rs. 572.00 crore was provided for repair and maintenance of roads, premix carpet/ surface dressing was carried out on 2026 km of road during 2013-14 besides carrying out patchwork and other special repair of roads.
- (e) Although repair is a continuous activity yet a lot has been done to restore confidence among the people to clear the backlog.

4. NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION

The total expenditure incurred on these works during the Financial year 2013-2014 is Rs. 407.27 Crores.

5. NATIONAL HIGHWAY

Out of the total length of 1957 km, 20 National Highways passing through the Haryana State, 11 National Highways with a total length of about 672 km are entrusted with the PW (B&R) Department for improvement and maintenance. The remaining 9 National Highways (NH-1,NH-2,NH-8, NH -10, NH -22, NH-71,NH-71-A, NH-73 & NH-65), are being improved and maintained by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI).

The department has incurred an expenditure of Rs. 50.91 crore against the allocation of Rs. 44.00 crore on the original works, Rs.27.77 crore against the allocation of Rs. 13.75 crore on periodical repairs and Rs. 2.43 crore against the allocations of Rs. 2.22 crore on the normal maintenance & flood damages restoration of the National Highways entrusted with the department. During this year, the activities under taken were as under:-

(A) Widening to 4- lanes

The Length of 5.30 km at a cost of Rs. 26.75 crore was under progress during the year 2013-14. An expenditure of Rs. 3.81 crore was incurred during the year 2013-2014. The work in 2.80 Km. was completed.

(B) Strengthening /IRQ

Strengthening of 87.80 km at a cost of Rs. 31.73 crore was under progress during the year 2013-14 on NH- 65, 71-B, 72 & 73 A & extension 709. The work on 66.32 km at a cost of Rs. 9.42 crore was completed during the year 2013-14.

(C) Miscellaneous Works.

In addition to the above, 13 miscellaneous works such as construction and repair of bridges, repair of railing of ROBs, preparation of DPR etc. were also taken up during the year. An expenditure of Rs. 14.60 crore has been incurred on these works during the year 2013-14. 4 miscellaneous works at a cost of Rs. 5.30 crore have been completed during the year 2013-14.

CRF WORKS

1. 3 roads having a length of 66.30 km with an estimated cost of Rs. 11622.81 Lac during the year 2013-14 were in progress under CRF. An expenditure of Rs. 2719.79 lacs was incurred on these works.
2. 2 Economic Importance Roads having a length of 26.88 km with an estimated cost of Rs.2637.37 Lac during the year 2013-14 were in progress. 1 road having length of 13.16 KM with an expenditure of Rs. 85.52 Lakh was completed.

6. PMGSY

1. The Pradhan Mantri Gramin Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) was launched by Govt. of India, through Ministry of Rural Development (MORD) on 25th December, 2000. PMGSY is a totally Centrally sponsored scheme. This programme has now been altered, expanded and renamed as Bharat Nirman. PMGSY is a sub section of Bharat Nirman.
2. Rs.1317.97 crore has been released by MORD since 2000-2001.The expenditure incurred is Rs.36.51 crore during the year 2012-13.
3. Physical progress during the year 2012-13 was 78 km against the target of 30.00 km.
4. As on 31 March, 2013, 46 Works of PMGSY phase IX were completed and pending 20 works of Phase IX were completed during the year 2011-12.

5. Pending 2 PMGSY works of phase-IX were completed in April, 2013.

7. NABARD PROJECT

(A) NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XIII

In this scheme, 85 bridges with a project cost of Rs. 81.14 crore, have been sanctioned, out of which 72 works were dropped. All works have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2013-14 was Rs. 0.48 crore.

(B) NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XIV

15 roads with a project cost of Rs. 133.64 crore and total length of 188 km under this scheme have been sanctioned, all works have been completed. The expenditure incurred during the year 2013-14 was Rs. 2.54 crore.

(C) NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XV(Roads)

In this scheme 14 roads, with a project cost of Rs. 146.52 crore having a length of 209.78 km have been sanctioned, All works have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2013-14 was Rs.5.60 crore.

(D) NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XVI(Bridges)

In this scheme 14 bridges with a cost of Rs. 50.00 crore were approved. 10 works have been completed and remaining are in progress. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2013-14 was Rs. 14.89 crore.

(E) NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XVI(Roads)

In this scheme 13 roads with a cost of Rs. 107.55 crore were approved. 11 works have been completed and 2 works are in progress. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2013-14 was Rs. 9.72 crore.

(F) NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XVIII(Roads)

In this scheme 25 roads with a cost of Rs. 272.92 crore were approved. 14 works have been completed and remaining an in progress. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2013-14. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2013-14 was Rs. 29.58 crore.

(G) NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XIX(Roads)

In this scheme 32 roads were approved with a cost of Rs. 389.61 crore has been approved from NABARD. Out of 32 works 25 works have been allotted during the period 2013-14.

(H)NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XIX(Bridges)

In this scheme 22 roads were approved with a cost of Rs. 100.63 crore has been approved from NARBAD during the period 2013-14.

8. BRIDGE/ROBs

23 bridges under Head 5054 with an approximate cost of Rs. 37.61 crore have been completed during the year 2013-14, 2 ROBs were completed at the cost of Rs. 74.26 crore and 21 Bridges under Head 5054 with an estimated cost of Rs. 69.94 crore were in progress during the year 2013-14.

9. Building

The department continued the construction as well as maintenance of the building works. The department also undertook the construction of non Govt./Semi. Govt. department building works as Deposit works.

During the year, 111 Buildings and 143 houses were completed. The total expenditure incurred on Construction and Maintenance of all type of buildings in the State was to the tune of Rs. 450.00 Crore.

ADMINISTRATIVE SETUP

The administrative & professional Head of the Deptt. is Engineer-in-Chief. There are seven Chief Engineers i.e. (i) Chief Engineer (Buildings), (ii) Chief Engineer (Roads), (iii) Chief Engineer (National Highways), (iv) Chief Engineer (Nabard), (v) Chief Engineer (Bridges) and (vi) Chief Engineer (NCR) (vii) Chief Engineer (Elect.& Mech.). Chief Engineers are responsible for their works to Engineer-in-Chief and Govt. There are 11-Civil Circles, one Mechanical and one Electrical Circle. Each Circle is headed by Superintending Engineer, generally consisting of three to four Divisions. There are 46 Civil Divisions, 5 Electrical Divisions & 5 Mechanical Divisions. Divisions are headed by Executive Engineers consisting of three to four Sub Divisions. Sub Divisions consist of three to four Sections headed by Junior Engineers in charge of Sections.

There is a well developed Mechanical wing headed by a Superintending Engineer (Mechanical) who reports to the Engineer-in-Chief through the Chief Engineer (E&M). The State has large fleet of machinery and it is maintained in the Central Mechanical Workshop at Karnal; besides a chain of regional workshops. There is an Electrical wing headed by SE (Electrical) who looks after the electrical works of the Buildings and reports to Chief Engineer (E&M).

The work of Horticulture wing is controlled by one Executive Engineers (Hort.) who is assisted by Sub-Divisional Engineers. The work of acquiring the land for buildings and roads is looked after by Land Acquisition Officers.

The State Research Laboratory is situated at Hisar and is headed by a Chief Engineer, designated as Director Research Laboratory. There is a Quality Control cell headed by Dy. Director at Hisar and Executive Engineers (Quality Control) located at Faridabad & Karnal, who examine the quality of materials and perform tests, independent of the construction agency. Apart from the main Research Laboratory at Hisar, there are regional laboratories at Bhiwani, Rohtak and Karnal besides the field laboratories working at sites of major construction works. During the year, 3618 no. samples were taken by Quality Control Cell, out of which 3586 were passed and 28 no are under re-checking.

Haryana State Roads & Bridges Development Corporation is headed by Managing Director-cum-Engineer-in-Chief, PWD (B&R) and assisted by Executive Director who is Chief Engineer on deputation from the Department and there are 7 no. DGMs located in field in the rank of Executive Engineers, are also on deputation from PWD (B&R) Deptt. Whereas, Haryana Rural Roads and Infrastructure Development Agency

(HARRIDA) is headed by Secretary General- cum-Engineer-in-Chief PWD (B&R) and assisted by Executive Director who is Chief Engineer (Nabard) and various PIUs in the rank of Executive Engineers posted in the field.
